



## **READING MALE VOICE CHOIR**

### **MEMBERSHIP FEES - POLICY ISSUES**

Membership fees cover rehearsals, music provision, uniform provision and concerts.

Membership fees are paid annually and cover the season (September-July)

Membership fees become due for payment at the first rehearsal of the season

Membership fees are not payable on a pro-rata basis, i.e. they are not due monthly, or by concert

Fees are set annually at the AGM by the whole choir membership

Those in financial difficulty have the facility to ask the Treasurer for a reduced rate which can be paid on an instalment basis

New members are asked to pay their annual membership when they are ready to sing in their first concert, when they will also receive their uniform. By this time they will already have had the benefit of rehearsals and music

No refund is are given when a member decides to leave the choir part way through the season (September-July)

No refunds are given if a member is unable to attend rehearsals or concerts, e.g. extended holidays or extended illness

#### **Retiring Membership**

When a member no longer sings in concert with the choir but wishes to retain affiliation with the choir they can be a 'Retiring Member'. This membership has an annual membership fee of £80. The retiring member may retain their uniform and may continue to attend rehearsals and receive choir information along with full members.
