# First - Download the app "Midi Sheet Music" from the app store.

# So now you can download the first song you want to try... from our website to your phone.

### The midi files page looks like this

- Touch and <u>hold</u> on the file that you want to download - - You should see this: (if you just tap it, it will probably start
- playing which isn't what you want)

## Tap on "Download linked file"

This will save your file into your "Downloads" folder.



# Now open the app

The first thing you see is a list of sample music (nothing to do with our songs)

So tap on "Files" and navigate to the folder with your Midi files.

And then just tap on the song you want to use and it will appear in the app, I will open Calon Lan



When you open a song – the words won't be showing.

So Tap on the / "Settings COG icon"

And Tap on the "Song Settings" option



You can explore the various settings yourself but here are my suggestions:

 Scrolling horizontally makes most sense

• You don't need the piano

• You certainly need to see the lyrics
